WHO: Students in grades K-12

WHAT: In celebration of the city's tricentennial, the San Antonio Museum of Art invites students in grades K-12 to tell their stories of our city's past, present or future through visual art.

WHEN: Student artwork will be displayed during the Museum's Free Spring Break Family Day: City Colorific on Tuesday, March 13, 2018, 12:00–4:00 p.m.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ARTWORK:

Create an artwork to tell your story. Size restrictions: 2D and 3D works must be no larger than 11" x 14" and no smaller than 4" x 4". 2D works must be mounted on cardstock. 3D works must be free-standing with no loose pieces.

Ask a classroom or art teacher to submit digital images of your artwork to citycolorific@samuseum.org. Works must be submitted by a teacher in order to qualify. **Please use the subject line Art Submission.** Include student's name, grade level, and school in the email.

DEADLINE: January 15, 2018

DETAILS: Artworks for display will be chosen by a panel of local artists. If an artwork is chosen, teachers will be notified by February 15, 2018.

Deliver accepted artworks to the Museum's Stables Studio between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., March 5th through 9th.

Pick up artwork at 4:00 p.m. on Spring Break Family Day (March 13, 2018) or from the Museum's Stables Studio the following week, March 19–23, between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
